From our BOM: We have had our 1st BOM management meeting for the current Board and the leading items of interest are as follows.

- 1. The Treasurer went through the year-to-date financials and the income stream is obviously lower over the winter months, but we are managing to keep spending under control. Our Term deposit has been reinvested at a better rate of 4.7% for the next 3 months (Up from 4.2%). Still working on suitable people for bar staff (Venue Manager).
- 2. It was agreed to proceed with upgrading the sprinkler system on D Green and Croquet Courts which will help to achieve better playing surfaces. Irrigation plays a huge part in this.
- 3. Further grant options are being sought for light upgrades on A & B Greens, with the Council.
- 4. Minutes of our meetings won't be displayed in the Club due to the necessity to keep our financial and other sensitive information confidential and in-house. However if you would like to receive a copy, please email our Secretary. After the Minutes have been confirmed by the Board, they can be sent to you. (Sensitive information that needs to remain at Board level only will be excluded).
- 5. John Maroney advised in General Business, that he has been offered a new job in Singapore and has accepted the position, which unfortunately means he has tendered his resignation as our Vice President. Damon thanked John for his work and advice in his time in the position and wished him the best for his future role. John also mentioned that he wishes all our Members and Club the best for the future. He will still remain a Member of the Club.



"Does it taste sweet?" says Paddy.


